Virginia and Sonny are both participating in the Surfside PCA Church youth mission trip to Belize in mid June. This will be their first time back to Belize since we completed our ministry there almost 3 years ago.

Please pray for them as they raise their funds and prepare their hearts and bodies for this experience. God has been very gracious about their support. They are very close to having everything they need. This trip will be filled with mixed emotions for them, and we would ask that you hold them up in your prayers.

Speaking of support, when we last wrote we reported that we had received commitments for 6 of the 70 monthly \$25 pledges that we need to maintain a positive balance in our support account. We are now up to 17 of those pledges! Praise the Lord. We only need 53 more! We are so grateful for the response we have received and look forward to seeing how God will continue to provide.
