Dear Friends in Christ Jesus,

The last part of the Scripture quoted in verse 17 in Quechua is God the Father saying: “This One is My much loved Son. With Him My heart is filled up....” We just wanted you to see how beautifully expressive the Quechua language is. It expresses so well in this verse just how completely satisfied the Father is with His Perfect Son. It tells us how important it is for us to let them know of the contentment that the Father has with His Son, Jesus Christ. Now, if Jesus is the only One that completely satisfies the Father, the One that fills Him up to the brim, then it is imperative for us to make that clear in their language because the devil is offering many unsatisfying substitutes. We want them to also be filled-up with Jesus by being filled with the Holy Spirit. Oh, to have hearts filled-up with Christ Jesus!!

We thank you so much for continuing to pray for Bolivia, the Quechuas, and for us as we continue to study the language and ask God for His wisdom on how and where to serve Him here in Bolivia once our language study is formally completed. We need His Divine leading to show us the way that He has prepared for us to follow. Your prayers are essential in this process, and we truly thank you!

In early December there was a Quechua Bible Institute held in Ironqollo, which is only about 45 minutes from Cochabamba. It lasted for an entire week, and all of the teaching was done in Quechua by members of New Tribes Mission. Keith Powlison, the Hinterland Director, sent three Peruvian leaders in the Quechua church in the San Jeronimo, Peru area to attend the Conference, and they stayed a couple of nights with us and the rest of the time they attended the Conference, along with Earl. They were truly blessed by the teaching and the fellowship, and they were also a great encouragement to the Bolivian Quechua believers also. They also received a lot of Quechua training materials from Cam Hurst, with New Tribes Mission, to take back and share with all the Quechuas in Peru. It was a very rewarding week for everyone who attended.

Around the middle of February, Earl received a call from Feliciano Caton, who helps Cam Hurst with New Tribes, about spending some time in the afternoons helping Earl with Quechua. What a blessing he is!! He and Earl are studying for an hour and a half every afternoon in the Quechua Bible. Feliciano really knows the Word and his heart is filled-up with Jesus. He is a real answer to prayer and a great encouragement to us. Your prayers are being effective!

Rosie is making steady progress in her Spanish language study as she goes every day to study with Tina. They have also become very good friends, along with the rest of Tina's family. Please pray for Tina and her family to have hearts filled-up with Jesus too!

We were very thankful to have many friends join us in celebrating Carla's sixteenth birthday on February 18th. We thank you for keeping her in your prayers also, as we ask the Father to cause her heart to be filled-up always with Jesus.

Well, we have filled-up all the space allotted for this letter, and we are filled-up with praise to the Father for you. Thank you for your regular and specific prayers because we see so many evidences of our dear Father's timely and good answers.

We would ask you to also pray for one other thing now, and that is that the Lord would help us to find a very good and affordable heavy-duty four-wheel drive vehicle that will be used in the Quechua ministry here as we prepare to be doing more and more out in the mountains with them. This is most needful and essential in the work.

Thank you again for your partnership with us in the Gospel. Your every act of love, support, and kindness is always causing our hearts to be further filled-up with praise to the Father for friends like you. You are precious in His sight and greatly valued by us also.
