Earl was able to leave Bolivia on Thursday, March 27th, and he arrived in Birmingham at the UAB Hospital CCU unit on Friday afternoon, March 28th. Our daughter, Lani Sewell, brought him there, where he was united with his other two brothers, Bruce and Jeff, and his sister, Angie Perry. There was no hope for Randy to ever recover from all of his many health issues. However, the biggest issue had already been settled only four months earlier when The Lord God Almighty saved his soul and made a new creation out of him and adopted Randy into His very own family. This was in spite of the fact that Randy had been a rebellious sinner for the prior 55 years. God was being very patient with Randy. Randy was saved under Micah's ministry, and then joined the Elkdale Baptist Church and became a regular attendee at the worship services where he then loved to hear God's Word powerfully proclaimed.

The word of this day and every day is GRACE!! God has shown him and us so much grace through Christ Jesus that our hearts are so full of praise for Him that we hardly can contain the admiration and love that we have for our GREAT GOD!!

Thank you again for remembering our family in your prayers. We would especially thank you for remembering our mother, who will be 88 years old next month, Lord willing. She is a delight, and a faithful witness.
