As we write this letter to you, our hearts are breaking over the news we just received concerning Earl’s brother, Randy. He has throat cancer and has been receiving chemo and radiation treatments. We don’t know if he will survive or not at this time, and if he does we don’t know the extent of the severe damage that has occurred. He is in the Lord’s hands. We pray that He will graciously give us all “a heart of wisdom,” and have pity on us and make our days glad as He shows His work to us and His glorious power to our children. Thank you for your prayers!

On a much more encouraging note, the Quechua Bible studies in Larat’i and in Bella Vista are being attended by more people each week. There continue to be new people coming, and the requests for Quechua and Spanish Bibles as well as Quechua hymn books continue at a high level. Pastor Rene is helping Earl a great deal in these two works. We thank the Lord for him and for those who are attending.

A few months ago, Earl met Boris, as we told you. He is one of the pastors with the Bolivian Presbyterian Church that was started here in Bolivia a number of years ago by the Brazilian Presbyterian Church. He invited Earl to meet with their presbytery, which met about 10 days ago, and they invited Earl to be a part of their presbytery. There are only five small churches represented by this presbytery in the whole country of Bolivia. We thank the Lord for this new partnership which He has forged. They have asked Earl to help them start a new church plant in the city of Cochabamba in the Cala Cala area. This will be a Spanish-speaking work. Earl has agreed to do so and to also keep on working with the two Quechua communities where the Bible studies are being conducted. They are now in the process of looking for a suitable and affordable place to start this new work. Your prayers are much needed for all of this.

Carla improved in her school work this past semester, and we thank the Lord for that. We are very grateful for all of you who remember her in your prayers so often. Thank all of you who also remember to pray for our older daughter, Lani, and her family back in Alabama as well.

Rosie and Earl are making some strides in their language studies, and we are thankful for the way in which the Lord is helping us to improve little by little and day by day.

Now we want to thank you for being such an important and vital link with us in work and ministry here in Bolivia. Your prayers, faithful giving, and many other acts of kindness and encouragement are answers to our prayers, and we thank the Lord so much for your partnership in the gospel. We do pray that the Lord will strengthen our feeble knees and allow us to see Him establish the work of our hands, which He has given us to do in His power and strength. Glory to His Name!!!!
