Dear Friends in Christ,

We are so thankful for the Gospel and for the unity that we have with you through faith in Christ Jesus, Who has given us grace, peace, and salvation through His death on the Cross in order to deliver us from this present evil age to the glory of God the Father. It is a tremendous comfort to know that He Who has done this greatest of all things for us will surely do many lesser things for us as well.

We began the new church plant this month by having a Wednesday night prayer meeting with some songs and a short devotional. It went very well. The next week we had a lot fewer people and even less last week. We have decided to change the Wednesday night meeting into a Bible study, and we will start with the Book of Galatians. We have also decided to start a Sunday Morning worship service beginning on Oct. 5th as we hope that many more people, including unbelievers will come. We really would appreciate your prayers for these services.

W had a wonderful visit from our Latin American Director, Bill Yarbrough, who was wise to talk to and fun to be with. We appreciate his efforts to come and minister to us.

We have also been very encouraged by the arrival of Miss Virginia Kruckeberg, a short-term MTW missionary who has arrived to teach the sixth grade at the Carachipampa Christian School. She is a visible answer to many prayers.

We were very disappointed that the medical team which planned to come on September 13-20th were not able to do so because of the cancellation of all American Airlines flights to and from Bolivia due to the civil unrest going on at this time. We were disappointed for them, for us, and for those to whom they were planning to minister. We appreciate all their efforts in trying to get here up until the very last minute. The team was coming under the auspices of the First Presbyterian Church in Jackson, MS.

However, in order to fulfill at least part of our commitment to the two communities that we had targeted, Dr. Jorge Gareca, and a dentist, Dr. Waldo Flores, along with my co-laborer, Rene Morales, and Earl went out there this past week for two days of ministry. They were so blessed to be there, and they were able to minister and share the Gospel with many different age groups in many different settings. Our group was able to pass out nearly 500 toothbrushes and some large tubes of toothpaste to every child and

professor in the two villages of Puna Kachi and Parte Libre, do a puppet show on dental hygiene, present Bibles to every professor and to the school principals, show the Jesus film in Quechua, show a kids video based on the life of David, and share the Gospel with the professors and principals in a private setting, with the community leaders in another private setting, as well as play games with the children. It was a wonderful trip! We thank the team that was coming for providing the toothbrushes, toothpaste, etc. for all the children.

Please keep Bolivia in your prayers as things continue to be unstable at this time. We desire to be able to stay here and minister to these people for as long as the Lord allows, and we do hope and pray that He will keep the doors open for the Gospel to be proclaimed here in every place freely. We are doing fine here in Cochabamba at this time, and we once again want to thank you for your fervent prayers, faithful support, and friendship in Christ.
