Specific Dates:

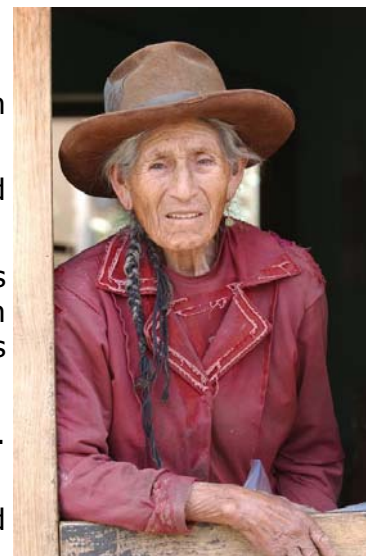
