8 – Larry will be speaking at a missions conference in Huntsville, AL. Please pray God would use him to call more workers to the field.

9 – Please pray that as Larry shares what God is doing among the Quechua that his vision would be refreshed and renewed.

10 – Larry travels back to Lima.

11 – Larry flies back to Huaraz. Please pray for protection over his luggage and safety in his travels.
