We hope this letter finds you pressing on in your faith trusting that our God and Father has all things under control including the economy, the elections and everything else. As believers we have a hope that others in these uncertain times don't have and therefore we can have peace and even joy.

Sandy and the kids arrived safely back in the States on September 17th and two days later the girls started school. Larry joined them 10 days later after getting things transitioned to our replacement, Scott Ross, who will be looking after the Center in our absence. We are still adjusting to being back. After being gone nearly 5 years some things have changed dramatically while other things haven't changed at all. The girls are getting into the swing of being in regular school and have made some wonderful friends. Homework is a challenge as being homeschooled all school work was homework so this is a big change for all of us. Jonathan is attending preschool two days a week and really likes it. There is a tiny African frog in some water in his classroom that he just adores.

God had provided a car for us that unfortunately was totaled when we were involved in a rear end collision when going out to eat following the missions conference at our home church. Thankfully no one was hurt, but we saw God's provision in that the car was an older model Lincoln Town Car and the size of it saved the girls from being seriously injured. He then provided a super car through another couple at church which we used until Larry's parents brought us their mini van to use. Through all of these challenges we have been brought to a higher level of learning to trust Him.

Larry has returned to Peru for two weeks in order to get out into the villages and keep contact with those he has been working with these past several years and the people that have just recently begun studying the Bible with him. He will be going back and forth several times during the next ten months. He also will be taking every opportunity to practice his Quechua so that he doesn't lose what he has worked so hard to attain.

Larry was also able to attend a Peacemakers conference covering conflict resolution and mediation since we have been back that we feel will be very useful in our work among the churches in our area. One of the biggest stumbling blocks to people listening to the gospel many times is the disunity and fighting they see among the evangelicals. One of our hopes is that God would use us to bring recon-

Then we will be driving back up to North Carolina. This is typical of what we will be doing while we are in the US.
- B. Please pray for Odilio that God would draw him to Himself. He has pulled out of the Catholic church but is looking into everything else to believe in rather than Christ.
- C. The small groups of people in the communities where we have been working don't believe we will be coming back. Please pray that they would be
