- Redeemer Presbyterian of Santa Rosa, CA

These four churches each agreed to support us financially and through ongoing prayer. There was also a stated desire among some to send short-term teams to Honduras once we get settled. We welcome such enthusiasm!

2 Weeks In North Africa

Erin served in North Africa from March 10th to March 23rd. She was on a medical mission team with 15 other doctors and nurses. They worked from 8am to 10pm each day and treated over 1000 patients. People were clamoring to receive free medical treatment from American trained medical personnel. The team prayed with almost every patient, both Muslim and Christian alike, and handed out Christian literature and Christian children's books in Arabic. Ninety percent of the people are Muslim.

The spiritual warfare was amazing. The five daily calls to prayer over loudspeakers, the open oppression of women, the government sanctioned persecution of Christians, and the poverty were all very challenging. Through all that, God's glory was evident.
