It is time to learn Spanish. Beginning on August 28<sup>th</sup> we will be fulltime students at the Spanish Language Institute in San José, Costa Rica. In Honduras they speak Spanish. We have been required to go to school and become fluent before we land in Honduras. For nine months the three of us will live in Costa Rica and attend a Spanish emersion program. We will attend classes fulltime. The school is designed for Christian missionaries needing to learn Spanish. So, some of the focus will be on acquiring evangelical Spanish. While we would love to hurry up and get to Honduras so we can start working, it is very important that we are fluent in Spanish so that we can communicate with the Honduran people.

## NYC Missions Training

We just returned from New York where we spent the entire month of July participating in an amazing missions training course put on by Mission to the World. We did a lot of hands on ministry work in a Columbian community in Queens. We also participated in some great lectures and exercises on church planting, team building, effective communication and language acquisition. This was a great experience. We acquired so many skills that will clearly help our missions work in Honduras.
