Support Raising Update

Our first month of support raising is complete. We have received pledges and contributions totaling 21% of our total financial need. In addition, we have received 200 requests to be added to our monthly prayer e-mail. Pretty good for one month of work. Praise God!

In the month of January we made over 500 support phone calls, sent 250 e-mails, mailed 65 packets, mailed 20 thank you cards, and had 41 appointments to share our presentation.

No Myanmar, Yes Africa

Erin's medical mission trip to the country of Myanmar was cancelled. The Myanmar government refused to issue the travel visas. But, God has other great plans for Erin. She has just been approved to participate in a medical mission trip to North Africa. We have been instructed not to name the country to protect the safety of the long term missionaries, short term missionaries and Christian nationals. The country is 90% Muslim and the government applies strict discriminatory policies concerning Christian

conversions, marriages, parenthood, education, church construction, use of media, employment, etc.

Erin and 15 other doctors and nurses will be there March 10th – 23rd. They will provide medical treatment at two orphanages and two temporary medical clinics.

Please pray for the safety of the participants. And, that God begins working in the hearts of those individuals the group will serve.

February 4th – 14th we will be in Arizona. We will be on a whirlwind tour of Arizona's Reformed and Presbyterian churches. We will be speaking to 12 churches in 11 days about their possible prayer and financial support.
