We have received pledges and contributions totaling 100% of our total financial need. We have also received 615 requests to receive our monthly prayer e-mail. Praise God! Also, three new churches recently joined Team Honduras:

This brings our total number of supporting churches to 12.

Spanish Language Institute

The three of us are now in San Jose, Costa Rica attending the Spanish Language Institute. We will be fulltime students here until June of 2008. We are required to attend school and become fluent in Spanish before we arrive in Honduras. This school is designed for Christian missionaries needing to learn Spanish. So, some of the school's focus is on teaching evangelical Spanish. In our class there 93 new adult students, almost all

are missionaries headed to Central or South America. Our family is living in a 600 sq. ft. apartment that is eight blocks from school.

While we are eager to arrive in Honduras so we can begin our work, we realize it is very important that we speak Spanish in order to communicate in Honduras.
